SUBMIT YOUR POSTER ABSTRACTS

Patient organizations, researchers, academics, industry, government agencies, and health care professionals are invited to submit a poster abstract for the 2019 RARE Patient Advocacy Summit on September 18-19, 2019 in San Diego, California. We invite those who have conducted research or program studies within rare disease to apply to present.

THEME

The theme of this year's RARE Patient Advocacy Summit is "Charting Your Course. Solutions for Evolving Needs in Rare Disease." We encourage submissions that align with our over-arching theme. Suggestions of specific topics include, but are not limited to: patient community building, patient support programs, innovative partnerships, collaborative relationships, and advances in medicine, research or technology.

POSTER DISPLAYS

- ⌘ Display boards with surface for push pins to secure the display will be provided on site.
- ⌘ Posters are to be displayed in landscape, with dimensions of 3'H x 4'W.
- ⌘ Posters should include data (summary, method, evaluation, results, demographics, etc.) for consideration. Preliminary and pilot data will also be accepted.

PRESENTER RESPONSIBILITIES

Presenters will incur all costs and responsibilities of presenting, including registration fees, hotel, travel and materials.

Accepted abstracts will provide a poster to be presented. Presenters must attend the RARE Patient Advocacy Summit.

Presenters must register for the event. Registration link will be provided upon abstract acceptance. Registration is through our software, Cvent, and presenters will have an opportunity to upload a biography, PDF of their abstract, and digital copy of their poster when registering.
