1. Who is eligible to apply?

Organizations providing direct or indirect relief to rare disease families displaced or impacted by the crisis in Ukraine.

2. How do I apply for this grant?

3. What should I do if I can't load or submit the application?

4. What projects will be accepted?

Accepted projects must be designed to have a specific and meaningful near term impact on rare disease patients and/or caregivers displaced by the conflict in Ukraine.

5. What is the maximum amount of funding an organization can receive through this grant?

Funding will be dependent on the scope and impact of the project.

6. What is the anticipated timeline:

- We request your organization to submit a brief report (template will be provided to you by Global Genes) 3 months after you receive the grant funding.

7. How will awards be disseminated?

Once your application is complete and all documentation is received payments will be processed.



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No funds can be transferred to a personal bank account. Funds must be transferred to an established bank account in the organization's name. Support groups can use their endorsing institution as the fiscal agent. Please note, to establish a bank account under an organization's name, you may need to apply for a Federal Identification Number.
